3	**	Students who fail to pay their tuition fees or complete course registration on time must apply with a document proving their excuse. Students whose excuses are approved by the Faculty/Vocational School Administrative Board will be granted the right to register.
4	***	The dates of make-up midterm exams will be determined by the administrative boards of the relevant units. Students must submit documents related to their excuse within 7 (seven) days following the end of the excuse period, either in person or via email to the relevant unit.
5	****	Student grades must be entered into the system within 7 (seven) days following the date of each final or resit exam.

MAXIMUM DURATION STUDENT EXAMS

(Supplementary Exams and Additional Period Exams – According to Law No. 2547, Article 44/c)

1. Only students who have reached the maximum duration (i.e., those who have been active since their year of enrollment and have completed 8 semesters for associate degree programs or 14 semesters for undergraduate programs) may benefit from these exams. Semesters in which the student did not register are counted within this period. Frozen (suspended) semesters are not included in this period. Years spent in the preparatory class are not included in this period.
2. These exams are conducted under the names ‘Supplementary Exams’ and ‘Additional Period Exams.’
3. In order to benefit from the Supplementary Exams, it is required to have completed the maximum duration (i.e., having actively completed 8 semesters for associate degree programs or 14 semesters for undergraduate programs based on the year of enrollment).
4. Supplementary Exams are offered for an unlimited number of courses, provided that the courses have never been taken, or the student has failed or had absenteeism. However, the Faculty or Vocational School Administrative Board may decide that students who have reached the maximum duration and have failed or had absenteeism must continue attending educational activities such as fully practical courses, partially practical courses, or project completion/graduation studies. If such a decision is not taken, students may take the Supplementary Exams.
5. Only 2 Supplementary Exam rights are granted to the student for all courses.
6. In order to benefit from Additional Period Exams, the number of failed courses as a result of the Supplementary Exams must be between 2 and 5. In this case, the student may benefit from a maximum of 3 Additional Period Exam rights for these courses.
7. At the end of the maximum duration, before taking Supplementary Exams, a student who has 2 to 5 courses that have never been taken, or have been failed or marked as absentee, may benefit from 4 Additional Period Exam rights for these courses.



8. If, as a result of Supplementary Exams or Additional Period Exams, the number of remaining courses is 1, the student is granted unlimited exam rights for that course. This exam is held together with the Single Course Exams at the end of each semester.
9. Students who have reached the maximum duration may benefit from summer school.

FALL SEMESTER

Students who have 2–5 remaining courses as a result of the Supplementary Exams conducted in the 2024–2025 academic year may benefit from the Additional Period Exams in the Fall semester of the 2025–2026 academic year (Details: Articles 6 and 7).

Fall Semester:

Application dates to benefit from the maximum duration supplementary exams: September 22–26, 2025

I. Supplementary Exams (or Additional Period Exams): October 1–5, 2025

II. Supplementary Exams (or Additional Period Exams): October 27–31, 2025

SPRING SEMESTER

According to the results of the Fall semester of the 2025–2026 academic year, students who have completed their maximum duration may benefit from the Supplementary Exams in the Spring semester of the 2025–2026 academic year; and students who have 2–5 remaining courses as a result of the Supplementary Exams conducted in the 2024–2025 academic year may benefit from the Additional Period Exams in the Spring semester of the 2025–2026 academic year (Details: Articles 6 and 7).

Spring Semester:

Application dates to benefit from the maximum duration supplementary exams: March 9–13, 2026

I. Supplementary Exams (or Additional Period Exams): March 23–27, 2026

II. Supplementary Exams (or Additional Period Exams): April 20–24, 2026
